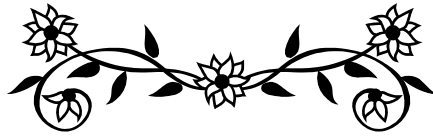

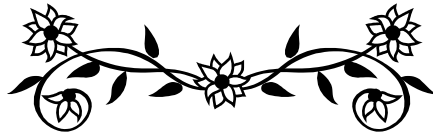

“I'd say---Duh!! I'll be there--of course you dont want to miss that!!!! Lol! ;)~ D.Paskaly!”

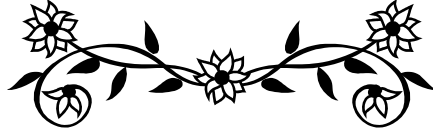
“Think of all those people and past friends who will miss you ~ we want you there or we won't have as much fun. Everyone changes and that's what life's about.”

“Why wouldn't you go - you have nothing to lose and the potential for gain.”

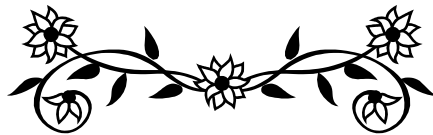

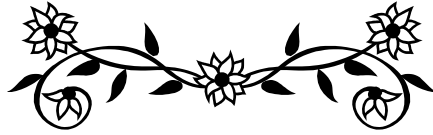

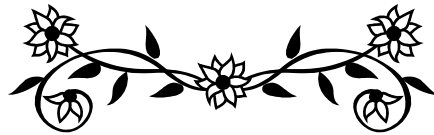
